BISHOP DENIS SPEAKS AT FR. LIAM'S RUBY JUBILEE

Liam, today the parish of Edenderry, your parish in every sense of the word, wish to say thanks for your ministry, your accompaniment to them in all aspects of life, school, sport, culture and the arts, and you being present particularly in vulnerable times of pain and bereavement.

For Edenderry, you are their priest, you are their chaplain, you are their neighbour, you are their brother. And they all care deeply for you. I thank you for so gently managing this parish in the immediate aftermath of Fr. PJ's illness, the sensitivity with which that candle remains lit on the altar is very moving. I also acknowledge Fr. Larry's contribution to this parish, which is also deeply appreciated.

Liam, your gift of composing is world renowned, I realise it's impossible to do it justice in these few lines. The composition 'The Cloud's Veil' written in the aftermath of the darkness of 9/11, 'The Hiding Place', 'The Voice of an Angel' and 'There is a Time' to mention but a few. In more recent years I think of the psalm you wrote for the final Papal Mass during the World Meeting of Families in 2018 'The Lord Hears the Cry of the Poor'. The many Mass compositions including the very well known 'Glendalough Mass', the 'St. Patrick's Mass' and the more recent 'St. Brigid's Mass'. You are a fluent Irish speaker and love the language, a love you gleaned from your late dad, your 'Aifreann Muire na nGael' comes immediately to mind. On a day like this I remember fondly your parents and your sister.

As we give thanks for your forty years of priesthood, a priesthood you held fast to, as you preformed before thousands in concert halls, stadiums and opera houses, and for that we are all so grateful. Every blessing this day. Ad Multos Annos.

Lord, in our work and play
we know your goodness and love.

Bless us with joy as we set out for our days of
vacation.

Let them bring us rest and refreshment.

Protect us as we travel.

Give us gentle weather and peaceful times.

Be with us at the meals we enjoy

and for each other.
