

Rorate Caeli Mass. 14th & 15th December.

On Saturday evening Mass we refer back to the Rorate Caeli Mass which is a traditional devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent and is offered normally just before dawn, but can also be offered at dusk. The interplay of light and darkness speaks to the meaning of Advent and the coming of the Light of the world. The Mass takes its title, Rorate Caeli, from the first words of the Introit, which are from Isaiah 45:8: "Rorate, caeli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum, aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem." "Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bud forth a Savior."

The Rorate Mass is lit by many candles, representing the Light of Christ coming into the world. It is a Mass in Mary's honour. In the dimly lit setting, the priest and people prepare to honour the Light of the world, who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. The Gospel today tells us that John the Baptist was to testify to `the true light, which enlightens everyone`. So, we ask for the grace to receive eternal life by the merits of the Incarnation and saving Resurrection of Our Lord.
